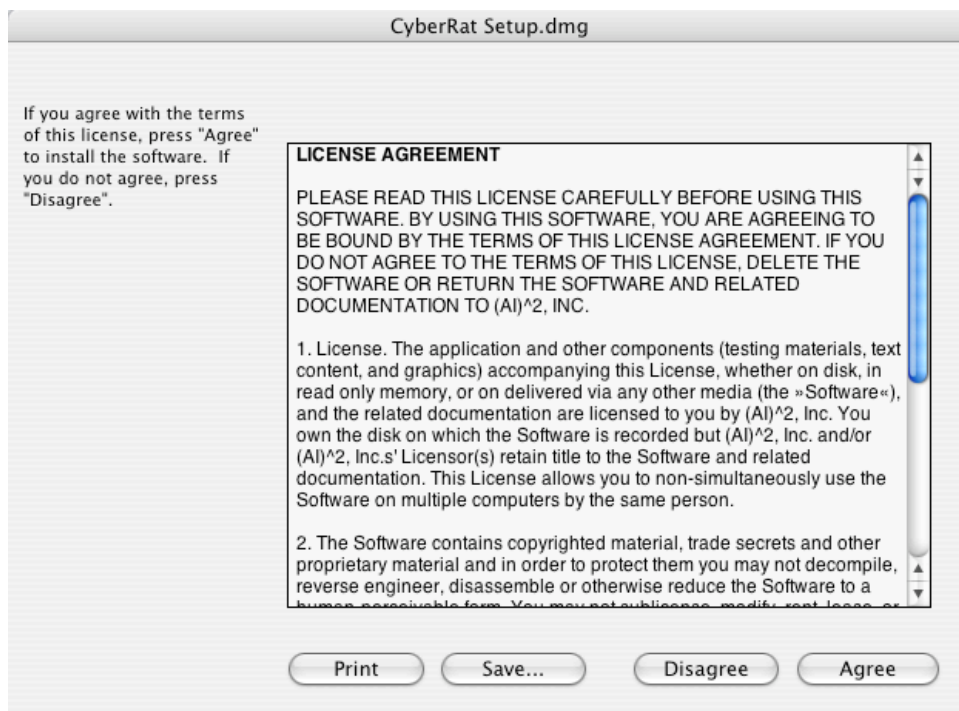


On Mac, CyberRat is downloaded as a ".dmg" file, which is the compressed archive that expands to so called "virtual disk". You need to copy "CyberRat" folder from this "virtual disk" to your hard disk, usually to "Applications" folder but if you wish, you can copy it to your "home" folder or to your "Desktop".  
This is the usual practice how Mac programs are downloaded and installed.

After download is complete you will most likely get the following message..



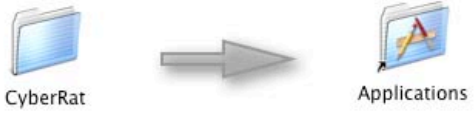
Click "Continue" and click "agree" on the license screen



In the following screen, just drag "CyberRat" folder from the left to the "applications" folder on the right which would copy "CyberRat" folder to "applications" folder on your hard disk.

Now, go to your desktop and drag to the "Trash" the "Virtual disk" icon that looks like this..



Also, go to your "downloads" folder ( it's in the dock at the right site) and drag to the "Trash" icon the looks like this...
